

## **Landlord/Tenant – COVID-19 Coronavirus – Suspension of Court Sessions Scheduled for March 16 – March 27, 2020**

This notice announces a two-week suspension of all landlord/tenant calendars as part of the Judiciary's ongoing efforts to contain the spread of the COVID-19 coronavirus. This suspension of landlord/tenant court proceedings will begin Monday, March 16 and continue through Friday, March 27, 2020.

Persons who are scheduled to appear for a landlord/tenant matter during this two-week period should not appear and should await notice of a rescheduled court date.

The Judiciary will work with the Special Civil Part Officers on the suspension of evictions (lockouts) of residential tenants during this same timeframe.

During this two-week period, court offices will remain open (and filings and payments will continue to be accepted).

Attorneys and litigants should contact the Vicinage Civil Division Manager's Office with questions about individual cases. All court users also should continue to check the Judiciary's public website ([njcourts.gov](http://njcourts.gov)) for current information
